
# Reference or Revelation? 7/9/2024

I have led many Bible studies on a variety of topics. I have preached sermons on what the Bible says about prayer, baptism, love, forgiveness, the end times, being a disciple, repentance, and dozens more. When people come to me for advice on difficult issues in life, like preparing to have a God honoring marriage, handling a divorce, loving a prodigal child, struggling through gender identity, dealing with abortion, kicking addictive habits, etc. I refer to the Bible, and pour through its pages so that I can find a solid, Biblical foundation on which to stand. I know that God's word is powerful: **Hebrews 4:12** – **For the word of God is living and active. Sharper that any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. Scripture is an amazing reference book.** 

Then it dawned on me. The word of God (the Bible) is not just a reference book. The word of God is also the revelation of God to humans. The word of God is Jesus (cf: John 1:1ff). Jesus reveals the character of God, the desires of God, the will of God, the forgiveness of God, the salvation of God, the grace of God, the heart of God, and the love of God. God sent His word, Jesus, to earth so that His nature, and eternal countenance might be grasped by frail, fragile, temporary humans. God wants us to know Him as much as is humanly possible.

When we love the word of God, we do more than love a reference book. We love His revelation. When we read the Bible, we should do more than look for proof-texts to validate our point or answer one of life's questions. We should be discovering God. If we faithfully seek Jesus in scripture, we will find God revealed. Read the Bible and let the revelation begin.
